Havasu Springs Resort is publishing this notice to inform its customers about the presence of Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) above the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) and/or Hazard Index (HI) for PFAS in drinking water.

The Arizona Department of Health Services has more information about the impact to health from PFAS. If you are concerned about potential health effects from exposure to these PFAS above the MCL and/or (HI), contact your doctor or health care professional.
